

Good Afternoon,

As a board member of a Not for profit organization, I have concerns regarding the specified model.

The proposal as I see it suggests that all users pay a base amount of \$241 per annum and a sliding scale for larger users.

I would propose that the model should exclude those who do not make submissions and therefore provide small risk for the purpose of chasing organised crime

Collecting \$241 from the 11,726 organisations sounds like a nightmare.

Over 98% reported volume and 99.76 % of the reported value can be attributed to the top five industry groups.

These groups are all shareholder based and subsequently the cost is passed onto the consumer.

The user pay system ensures that a charge is made when the service is used.

I would ask that you consider excluding Not for profit organisations that endeavour to support and enrich our community.

Organisations driven by the profit motive are better able to pay the bill and **will** pass it on to their customers.
