





## Quick reference – Uploading IFTI-E v2.0 files for reporting using IFTI-E v2.0 schema only

This guide will show you how to submit an IFTI-E v2.0 file in AUSTRAC Online (AO). **Please note:** This guide may be subject to change. Data used in screenshots are fictitious.

- 1. Follow the reference guide for "User login and access" to get to the submissions page and also to log out when you have finished,
- 2. Click in the **Submit file** box. Select your report file and click **Open.** Alternatively, you can drag and drop your report file onto the **Drag 'n' drop** button.

 The file name will appear. If your file has the correct name format, file type and size, the file is ready to be submitted.



Click on the **bin** icon Click on the **Submit** to remove the file. Click on the **Submit** icon to submit the file.

4. You will get a confirmation when the file has been successfully submitted. Click on the X to close the message box.

Drag 'n' drop your file here, or clic Single .xml or .zip file only, up to 30 Mb	k to select a file.

## Important note

The report file needs to follow these file rules or you will get an error message. File must:

- be smaller than 30MB;
- have file name format consistent with 'IFTI-Eyyyymmddsssssss';
- be a xml file or a zip file (.xml, or.zip); and
- meet IFTI-E v2.0 schema specifications.

If shown error, fix the error and repeat step 2.



5. The submitted file will appear in the **Submissions Table**.

Submit status	Refresh submissions table to update the file status.
In progress —	<ul> <li>File validation is in progress.</li> </ul>
Accepted —	<ul> <li>File validation passed.</li> </ul>
Action required	<ul> <li>Refer to guide "File resubmission or no further action" for next steps.</li> </ul>

6. An email will be sent to you, either confirming that the file was accepted or has failed validation. For failed validations, refer to guide "File resubmission or no further action" for next steps.
