1 Name

This instrument is the *Anti-Money Laundering and Counter-Terrorism Financing Amendment (Revocation of Instruments — multiple entities) Instrument 2026 (No. 12)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument is made under paragraph 248(1)(a) of the *Anti-Money Laundering and Counter-Terrorism Financing Act 2006*.

Schedule 1 — Repeals

1. *Exemption 7 of 2008*

Exemption granted to Foresters Financial Limited (formerly Ancient Order of Foresters in Victoria Friendly Society Limited) on 29 April 2008

Repeal the whole of the instrument.

2. *Exemption 1 of 2009*

Exemption granted to Anglican Managed Investment Fund Diocese of Bathurst on 9 February 2009

Repeal the whole of the instrument.

3. *Exemption 4 of 2015*

Exemption granted to Indue Limited on 5 July 2015

Repeal the whole of the instrument.

4. *Exemption 10 of 2015*

Exemption granted to Automatic Data Processing Limited on 6 November 2015

Repeal the whole of the instrument.
